

# A Message from Father Aaron Take Courage and Wait for the Lord

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

As a young boy I loved the Season of Advent and all the traditions that made it special. The Church decorations stood out so well, dressed in violet, a sign of waiting, preparation and repentance. The music turned our hearts to God in hope and expectation of something new and good about to take place. And the Advent candles stood as a reminder of the light getting brighter as we neared the day of celebration when the Savior comes to earth, the true Light of the earth.

Advent serves as a special time of preparation for our hearts to meet the Child Jesus in a very special way. In a sense it brings out the excitement of a child in all of us. The worldly mindset too often makes Christmas into a materialistic feast of wants and "needs", but this is a distortion of the very meaning of the Season. It is a Season of generosity and giving. We seek to give our hearts to Christ so that He can be the special gift inside of us that is given to others. This is what the world truly longs for, genuine love from the heart. And what is true love? It is embodied in the Person of Jesus Christ, who came to us a the little child to show us how. "...and a little child will lead them."

What are the deepest desires of your heart? In what ways do you long for true peace? How will you open your heart to Christ in a deeper way this Advent? Let Him be your deepest desire and peace in life.

# How can you, and we as a Church family, make this Advent special this year? Here are a few suggestions.

1. Put an Advent wreath in your house. Say an extra prayer around as a family each day or as often as possible.

2. Do an act of mercy for another in need. Give of your time, talent or treasure.

3. Celebrate St. Nicholas with your your family and tell his story to the children.

4. Exchange "Advent Angel" names to pray for one another and perhaps do "secret" acts of kindness.

5. Take in a Christmas prayer service.

6. Make a good confession with your family, or just by yourself.

7. Play good sacred Christmas hymns in your house through the Season.


