## 2019-2020 Online Faith Formation Agreement Form

**Dear Parents:** 

Please complete this form **ONLY** if you are signing up your children for the *My Catholic Faith Delivered* on-line religious education course for students in grades 1-6 & 8-9.

The Church of St. Anthony will once again offer *My Catholic Faith Delivered* to our parish families. The Church understands that parents are the primary educators of the faith. This program puts the responsibility for the faith formation of their children back into the hands of parents. The web address is <a href="mycatholicfaithdelivered.com">mycatholicfaithdelivered.com</a>, under the menu heading "Faith & Life" for grades 1-6, 8-9. The online classes are designed to be completed weekly or spaced out throughout the year as best as you are able.

In addition to the on-line courses of *Faith & Life* parents will need to ensure that the additional requirements of the religious education program are met. These include:

Student Masses: As the Eucharist is the source and summit of our faith, students are required to attend student Masses when offered. <u>Please</u> refer to the calendar to see when Mass is being held. If your student would like to participate in their grade's Mass, please let the office know as soon as possible so that they can be included in the planning.

<u>Reconciliation Services</u>: In both the Advent and Lenten seasons, Church of St. Anthony offers student Reconciliation Services on a Wednesday night and parish-wide penance services on a Sunday. Please be sure your students are able to attend one of these services in each season.

<u>Safe Environment</u>: A requirement of the Diocese of New Ulm and the entire Catholic Church of the US (as set forth by the USCCB), is that each student receive Safe Environment training each year. This is tracked by the Diocese of New Ulm. Training materials will be provided for all families in *Faith & Life*, or you can attend the Wednesday night training provided by religious education program on September 18 for elementary students, and October 9 for students in grades 6-9.

<u>Retreats, Meetings and Rehearsals:</u> Students preparing to receive 1<sup>st</sup> Reconciliation and 1<sup>st</sup> Eucharist will be required to attend the Retreats, Meetings, and Rehearsals for each sacrament. Please refer to the calendar to see when these are being held.

<u>Prayer Testing:</u> Prayer is one of the most important aspects of our faith and is our best way to communicate with God. Parents will be asked to "test" their children on their prayers appropriate for their grade level throughout the year.

We are asking families to submit a reason why the online program is the best cho for your family. You can do this below:		

The online course begins September 11, 2019 and ends April 29, 2020.

To be eligible for the online program you must be either new to the online program or have <u>completed</u> the online program as well as the additional requirements, the year before. Anyone who was enrolled in the online program but has not completed the course from the previous year as well as the extra requirements will not be eligible to enroll in the online program for this next year.
