A Message from Father Jerome



Palm Sunday: The Church celebrates today as both Palm Sunday and Passion Sunday. Today's liturgy combines contrasting moments of glory and suffering - the royal welcome given to Jesus by his followers and the unjust drama of his trial culminating in his crucifixion. Holy Week challenges us to remember and relive the events which brought about our redemption and salvation, to appreciate gratefully the price Jesus paid for our salvation, and to return God's love for us, expressed through the suffering and death of Jesus, by loving others. The meditation on these Paschal mysteries should enable us to do our own dying to sin and rising with Jesus, which will result in our healing, reconciliation, and redemption. Proper participation in the Holy Week liturgy will also

deepen our relationship with God, increase our faith and strengthen our lives as disciples of Jesus.

"Don't miss the best part!" That's my advice as we approach the end of Lent. The liturgical services on Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion and the Easter Triduum (Holy Thursday through Easter Sunday) are among the very best things we do in the church. I know that they are "different" and "long." But isn't that to be expected? Special events-a daughter's wedding or a grandson's Baptism-usually cause us to change our routine and our ordinary way of doing things. And, yes, they may be a bit "longer"-special events often are. For example, Thanksgiving dinner takes longer than an ordinary Thursday dinner. That should not surprise us.

I described in this special bulletin what goes on during these days to entice you to participate in these liturgies if you are not in the habit of doing so; and if you are already a "regular" during Holy Week, I am sure that brief explanation helped you enter into "our holiest week" with an even greater appreciation of its meaning. If you have not received this special bulletin, please pick from the back of the church.
