



A Message from Father Aaron


Today, Trinity Sunday, we celebrate our Triune God who is Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Our Father in Heaven is a God of the mysterious relationship of love of three Divine Persons. The Father proves his love for us by sending his only Son as the God-Man to walk with sinful humanity and shows us the way, the truth and the life. Contrary to what we are tempted to believe at times, Jesus came not to condemn us, but rather to help us, lift us up and encourage us. St. Paul does the same in his message to the Corinthians, as we are given words to live by, "Mend your ways, encourage one another, agree with one another, live in peace, and the God of love and peace will be with you."

Words of encouragement and affirmation can be powerful motivators and moments of grace. We know how easy it is for us to overlook or downplay an encouraging word. Too often we remember not the many positive things over the span of a day, but rather dwell on the one negative event or word spoken to us. However, an encouraging word gesture can never be underestimated. For many of us also remember the moment when a teacher, relative, friend or religious leader made a powerfully positive impact on our lives. Just one simple word or gesture can make a great difference.

As followers of Jesus Christ we are all called to bring light into the darkness of the world. We are all called to see Christ in our neighbor, and we hope that others will see the same in us. One way we can do that is to encourage one another. This doesn't mean we "fake it" or call the average and mediocre performance "good." Rather, it means that we actively search out ways to authentically give; affirmation for good works done, words of gratitude, an act of kindness, a positive gesture, words of hope and inspiration, encouraging words, promises of prayer and messages and actions that find their source in the source of all things good, Jesus Christ. What would our life be like if we replaced words of complaint and negativity with ones of encouragement? How would this change the world if we would strive to do this?

May we all continually ask God for the grace to be a light of encouragement for Christ in our world so that the God of peace will be with us.

P.S. I will be off to the Chippewa National Forest in northern Minnesota this week for a camping and fishing trip. Perhaps say a little prayer for safe travel and good weather...and a few fish of course! Thank you!
