A Message from Father Aaron

Trusting in the Goodness of God

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Jesus says in our Gospel today, "He who sows good seed is the Son of Man." God desires to plant good things in the hearts of believers so that we may bear good fruit for him. In all things God is trustworthy because He only wants the good for his children.

This week is NFP (Natural Family Planning) awareness week in the Church. (I realize that this is a very sensitive issue for some, so please do look at the resources below and feel free to contact me personally at the office or email me if you have any questions.) This is certainly not just a woman's issue. Men must be equally involved! I would certainly take the time to further explain the Church's teaching on this very important issue. Thank you in advance for reading about this week's topic.

This week we promote the gift of life in marriage and family recognizing the beauty of God's design and trusting in his goodness. NFP, although at times misunderstood, continues to grow and make a wonderful impact on families in the Church. NFP permits us to be open to discerning God's plan when bringing children into the world, while the use of contraception does not allow us to be open to discerning God's plan, but rather is closed off to God's plan as we instead choose our own.

Utilizing contraception distorts the Divine plan for human life while displaying a lack of trust in the goodness of God. Again, this selfish act is not open to discerning God's will, but rather puts ultimate control over human life into the hands of human beings. This is power that we were never meant to have. It is because of this prideful turning towards one's own plan that causes this act to be sinful. All human life in meant to begin and end with God. "All good giving and every perfect gift

is from above, coming down from the Father." (Jms 1:17) The rise and now rampant use of contraception has had a tremendously damaging effect on our culture and our Church. May we pray for an increase in respect for all human life throughout the Church and the world, so that God's loving plan for human life may be known and trusted.
